IMPORTANT SELECTION CRITERIA

ATHLETES

There are a number of key criteria used in the selection of an Athlete for the Sports Hall of Fame. While there is a significant judgement factor, the committee attempts to, where possible, assess nominations on the basis of the hard facts submitted by the nominator. A brief outline of each major criteria follows:

ABILITY LEVEL

- Was the Athlete superior in terms of ability in the sport(s)?
- Did the Athlete excel in terms of awards and honors? e.g. scoring championships, MVP's, medals, all-star selection
- Was the Athlete recognized by peers, public, media, etc. as being "one of the best" in the sport?
- List by type and year, if available, all important statistics, awards and honors.

COMPETITIVE LEVEL

- Did the Athlete participate at a local, provincial and national level?
- If so, at what competitive level and how frequently? (e.g. all-star for 10 years)
- List significant provincial and national competitions and years participate.

SCOPE OF INVOLVEMENT

- Did the Athlete participate in more than one sport?
- If so, how many and at what competitive and ability level?
- List sport and years involved and extent of involvement.

CHARACTER AND SPORTSMANSHIP

- Did the Athlete frequently display a superior brand of leadership?
- Was the Athlete recognized for his leadership? (most gentlemanly participant, awards, etc.)
- Was the Athlete chosen as a Leader/Captain of team?
- Did the Athlete have a reputation for fair play and sportsmanship?

DURATION OF DISTINCTION

- How long was the Athlete involved in the sport(s)? (1 year, 5 years, 20 years)
- Was this involvement at a high competitive level for the full duration of time?
- Provide details by year of involvement by sport.

BUILDERS

There are a number of key criteria used in the selection of a Builder for the Sports Hall of Fame. While there is a significant judgement factor, the committee attempts to, where possible, assess nominations on the basis of the hard facts submitted by the nominator. A brief outline of each major criteria follows:

INITIATING AND FOUNDING EFFORT

- Was the Builder responsible for initiating the sport from the very beginning?
- If so, to what degree? (e.g. strong individual leadership)
- Attempt to outline early years of sport and personal contribution of individual in terms of significant events.
- This is an important category - attempt to list early contributions.

ADVANCEMENT AND DEVELOPMENT

- Would this sport have survived without this Builder's contributions?
- Did the individual really carry the sport through its development years?
- Does the Builder have a reputation amongst his peers, public and media as being the "prime mover" for the sport?

LEVEL AND QUALITY OF INVOLVEMENT

- Did the Builder participate in a leadership role? E.g. President. If so, for how many years?
- Was the leadership role at local, provincial or national level?

SIGNIFICANCE AND SCOPE OF SPORT

- Is the sport in question a major sport (provincially and nationally)?
- Is the sport a well-established sport or a relatively new sport?
- A strong contribution by a Builder on a local level would clearly qualify.

DURATION OF INVOLVEMENT

- How many years did the Builder participate in a leadership role?
- List, if possible, years of involvement for each sport.
- List the sports, the years involved and office or position held by Builder.
